Insurance

Treatment at Palmetto Lowcountry Behavioral Health is covered by most insurance plans, including Medicare and TRICARE®. At this time, all Managed Medicaid is accepted and South Carolina Medicaid can be accepted only for patients under the age of 21 and over the age of 65. Prior to admission to any of our programs, we will contact the insurance provider to verify eligibility and determine the patient's benefits. Please call if you have questions about specific eligibility. We also offer self-pay options.

How to Make a Referral
